### Year 4 Eid Assemblies

This week, Year 4 performed their class assembly about Ramadan and Eid to families. The assembly focused on the holy month of Ramadan and children performed a role play about Ibrahim - a young boy who wanted to fast for the first time. They explained what Muslims traditionally do during this month and why it is so important to them. The assembly portrayed lots of our school values such as caring, generosity and respect. All children took part with confidence and put on a fantastic performance! It is lovely to see children exploring and celebrating a variety of religions at Marsh Hill.

### **Dogs On The School Premises**

I would like to remind parents to book their child's school meals. Bookings can be made on the Teachers2Parents app up to midnight the night before the meal is required. There are always at least two weeks of meal bookings available for parents to pre-book.

We ask parents to book their main meal choice so we can give our excellent catering staff accurate numbers. As you can appreciate if bookings are not made then this has implications in the correct number of meals being cooked. Text message reminders are sent out on a Thursday and Sunday.
