Ask your child to say a 2 digit number e.g. 26. encourage them to count from 26 to 100 Can they count backwards and remember to stop at 26? Please can you write the number in words on different pieces of paper from 1-20. Place the paper in different places around your home and encourage your child to read the words.

Throughout the week continue to ask your children number bond questions e.g. What numbers make II? I add IO? What is the total of 6 and 5? 8 plus 3 ...

Teach your child the rhyme 'One Two Buckle My Shoe' One, two Buckle my shoe,

Three, four Open on the door,

Five, six ...Pick up sticks,

Seven, eight Lay them straight,

Nine, ten A good fat hen,

Eleven, twelve Dig and delve,

Thirteen, fourteen Maids a-courting,

Fifteen, sixteen Maids in the kitchen,

Seventeen, eighteen Maids a-waiting, Nineteen, twenty My plate's empty.
