What does it feel like? Can you describe the taste?

Write a sentence using some of the describing words you used.

Start sentences with a capital letter. End sentences with a full stop

Leave a finger space after each word.

Sit your letters on the line.

Maths

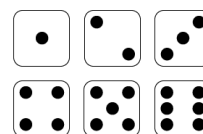
Play Roll the dice to help your child develop counting skills. Roll 2 dice and encourage your child to add the total on both e.g.

$$6+6 =$$



As your child plays encourage them to recognise the dots and to count on (e.g. put 6 in your head and count on pointing to the dots...7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12)

If you do not have a dice; draw the dots on sheets of square paper twice



Then your child can take turns turning over 2 sheets of paper. It is not essential that you send pictures of the addition sentences. We would like your child to play the game regularly

- so that they can recognise the amount of dots on the dice without counting them
- recall number facts quickly in a fun way.

If you know any number rhymes please spend time singing them with your child. E.g. Ten Green Bottles

10 green bottles sitting on a wall

10 green bottles sitting on a wall
