**Maths: Time vocabulary**

Talk about what you did during different times of the day. The morning, afternoon, evening and night time.  
Talk about your daily routine.

**Halving and sharing**

Get different amounts of objects 1-20, then share them into **2 groups**. "I for me and 1 for you". (e.g. 10 objects, share into 2 groups, so half of 10 is 5!)  
Always find half of a number after sharing them into 2 groups first.
