Red words to read and spell: are was</p>	<p>English WALT: use capital letters and full stops accurately.</p> <p>To begin, please ask your child where we use capital letters and full stops in sentences and why we use them.</p> <p>We use capital letters to mark the beginning of a new sentence to show that a new idea has begun and we use a full stop at the end of a sentence to show that the sentence is finished and a new sentence may begin.</p> <p>We also use a capital letter for the pronoun I and at the beginning of a proper noun such as the names of people or special places.</p> <p>Today we would like you to practise using capital letters and full stops and recognise where they should go.</p> <p>Please complete the activities for your group and send it back to us.</p> <p>You can either handwrite it and send us a photo or complete it on the google slides and send it back to us.</p>		<p>Maths</p> <p>This week, we are moving on to some work about 2D and 3D shapes.
