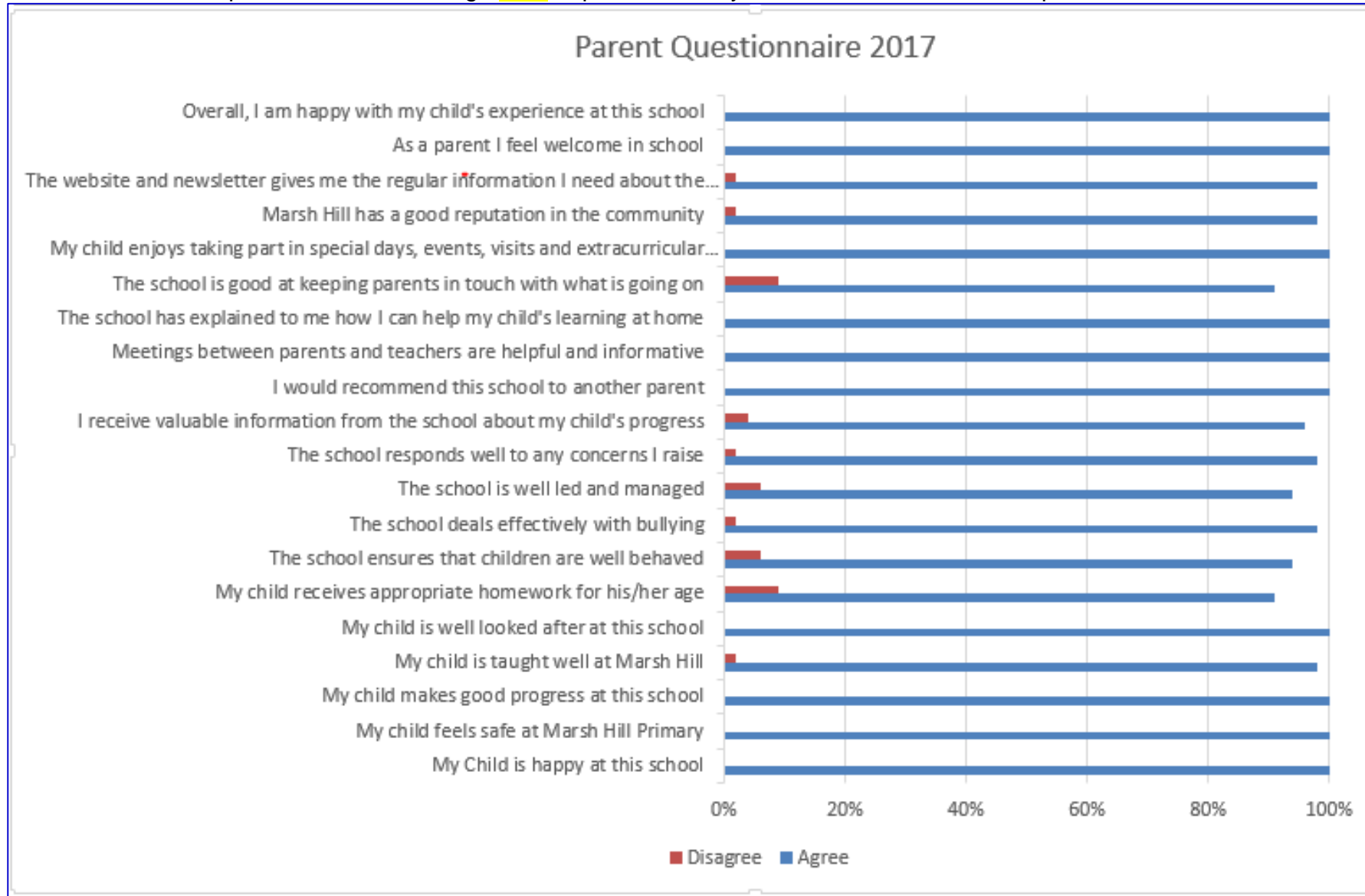




The results of the 2017 annual questionnaire (from 47 parents) are displayed below. The survey was undertaken in order to ascertain Parental Views about the school within a number of key aspects. In addition, parents also had the opportunity to add personal comments about Marsh Hill Primary. All parents are reminded that if they have any worries or concerns that they must not hesitate to contact the school.

We were pleased that on average **98%** of parents surveyed were satisfied with all aspects of school life.
