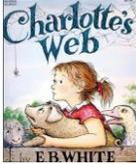

Some of you may have pets at home so you will already be able to think of lots of great reasons.</p> <p>Read the reasons below and use some of the ideas and any of your own to <b>create a poster. This poster has to show all the benefits of having a pet.</b></p> <p>Your poster needs to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ A title</li> <li>▪ Sub headings</li> <li>▪ Illustrations</li> <li>▪ Persuasive language</li> <li>▪ Clear reasons of the benefits of having a pet</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>LO: to write my diary entry</u></b> We are ready to start our writing. We have got our plans which we are going to use to help us.</p> <p>When we write our diary entry we have to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Time conjunctions (first, next, then, after that,)</li> <li>▪ Emotive language (including similes and metaphors)</li> <li>▪ Sentences describing the senses (how you feel, what you touch, what you can see and hear)</li> </ul> <p>We also need to think about our sentence structure.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Sentences need to be well constructed. **Activity 1**

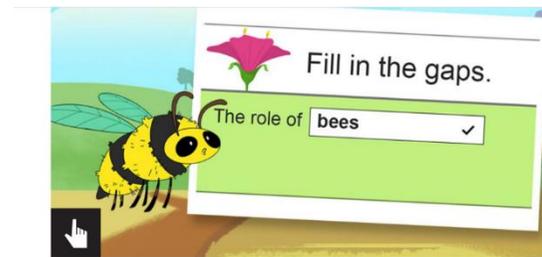
