Special words called **prepositions** are in the story (**on, under, below, in, into, off, up, above**). Listen to the story did you hear any of these special words e.g. on under, in, off. Can you act out the story again and use these special words? I am going to put a helmet **on** my head. I will sit **in** my rocket.

Science: Our Five Senses

Go for a sense walk around your home.

What can you see? Discuss this is the sense of Sight

What can you feel? Discuss this is the sense of touch

What can you hear? This is the sense of hearing

What can you smell? Finally what can you taste?

Play a taste game. An adult can blind fold you, can you guess the mystery food. Discuss what it feels like before eating it!

Maths: Counting Write your numbers from 1-20 e.g. on paper squares or cupcake cases. Count out the correct amount of objects that you have in your home e.g. 3 leaves, 4 peas, 15 stones etc.

Challenge can you count more than 20 objects correctly?



An adult can ask you questions e.g.

What is 1 more than 10? ... 1 more than 18?

What is 1 less than 15? ... 1 less than 20

Art & DT: Construction

Baby Bear turned an old box into a rocket. Can you make a rocket using a box? It can be a small box e.g. a cereal box or a large box.

Then draw a picture of what your rocket looks like? Ask an adult if they can take a picture of your rocket.
