

Reception Homework Week Beginning

Monday 19th October 2020



Over the next few weeks, it is essential that children learn to write their name. They Must only have the first letter as a capital NOT the entire name e.g Danny, Anne etc. Please practise writing this as many times as possible daily as it is an expectation that they learn how to do this after half term.

Tips for name writing

Trace over dotted lines of each letter or children trace over their highlighted name.

Display their name around the house e.g. fridge, wall.

Encourage the correct pencil grip and keep reminding them if they deter and go back to using incorrect pencil grip.

Use letter magnets or letter blocks to build their name so they learn how to spell and write it.

Practise changing clothes

Next week, we will be starting P.E - it is vital that children learn how to change. Practise changing and unchanging e.g pyjamas at night time - can they undress independently?

Also, can they practise putting on their coats and zips independently?

Number

Practise counting rhymes with the children and also counting objects. Can they count objects around the house? E.g socks, toys, blocks.

Parents to shout out a number and children to count the same number of objects.

Also children to practise counting actions such as claps, jumps, hops etc.
