Tips for writing.

Encourage the correct pencil grip and keep reminding if they deter and go back to using incorrect pencil grip. We call this a pincer grip.

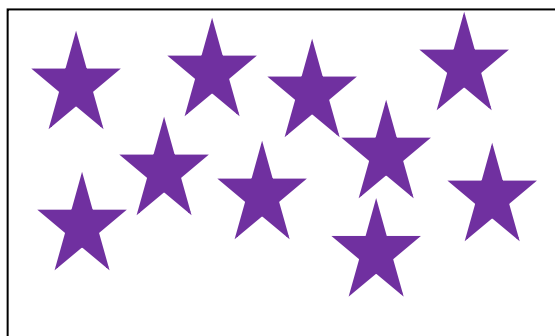
Make sure they are sitting comfortably so that their back can be straight and their hand that they are not using to write placed on the book as a support.

Practise changing clothes.

Please try to put on your own coat and do up the zip, after it has been started. Try to hang up your own coat on a hook. Learn how to fold your clothes after you have taken them off as this will help you not lose your clothes when we do PE.

Number

We are continuing to count objects that can be moved but also to count objects that cannot be moved. Ask an adult to draw some shapes onto a piece of paper for you to count. If you can try to write the number that you have counted.



Ask an adult to draw objects in different arrangements - can you count all the way to 20?
