Dear Parents and Carers,

Attendance

At Marsh Hill, we firmly believe in the importance of attendance and we work closely with Birmingham Local Authority and parents to ensure that all children are in school every day. Research clearly demonstrates that absence disrupts the education of the individual pupil and of the whole class generally. Children who do not attend regularly:

- Do not achieve as well as their peers in exams
- Find it difficult to build and maintain friendships
- Are more likely to become involved in crime
- Miss out on opportunities in further education and the world of work

I have recently had a number of families contact me about leave in term time. Since the 2013 amendment to The Education (Pupil Registration) Regulations 2006, Head Teachers may no longer authorise leave during term time except where the circumstances are exceptional. This is in accordance with Birmingham Local Authority's 'Leave in Term Time Guidance.' If families choose to take leave in term time, they may be subject to legal procedures.

Achievement Assemblies

Booking Dinners

Instructions on how to book your child's dinner is below.




You will only need to register and login to the Eduspot App once. Once you have done this, the app will remain permanently logged on, unless you delete the app or logout.

First, you will need to download the app onto your device through the relevant app store; it is compatible with both Android and Apple IOS.

Once opened a screen will pop up, this screen will ask you to register your mobile phone number. It will match that phone number with the one on record at the school, so please ensure the school has your correct details.

After your phone number has been entered you will be asked for a verification cade. This will be sent via SMS to the mobile number you entered.



When you are logged into the app, you will be sent to the homepage. This will show you an overview of any new or panding payments that need your attention. By selecting a payment from this screen, it will take you directly through to the Payments section and allow you to odd it to the basket as needed.

To navigate the app, use the manu located in the left hand comer of the screen. If you want to return to the homepage at any paint, click an Eduspot at the top of the screen.



If you would like to pay for or book dinners for your child, open the menu side bar in the top left and select Dinners. This will open one of two pages; an averview of school lunches for the week or Dinner Top Up Icon.



If you are expected to pre book your child's dinner days, when you navigate to the Dinners section of the app you will see a list of the weeks available to book. Select the drop down arrow at the bottom of that week's box and it will expand.

Please Nate: If your child is eligible for free school meals or universal infant free school meals then you can book as narmal but will not be charged.



Pre-booking specific meal aptions allows you to choose daily meals from the schools available menu.

When expanding the week with the drop down arrow you will see a list of days that are available to back with a drop down of meal chaices. Select the meals and when you're ready, select the green plus icon to make the booking and add it to your basket.



Once you have everything you wish to pay for, select the value top right. This will send you to the Basket poge.

Here you will see the name of the school your child(ren) attend and the total to pay.

Please Note: if you have children at multiple schools that use SchoolMoney, each school will be listed. You will need to check out of these separately.
