Focus on the Curriculum – Mathematics

At Marsh Hill, we are MATHEMATICIANS! We want our children to love Maths! We want them to have no limits to what their ambitions are and grow up with secure mathematical understanding which will assist them in whichever career path they take, as well as in their daily lives.

In order to successfully deliver a structured, rich curriculum with a clear progression of skills, we follow the statutory requirements of the National Curriculum for mathematics. At Marsh Hill Primary School, our approach to teaching mathematics is intended to support all of our children in becoming young, confident mathematicians; prepare them for their next stage of mathematical learning at secondary school, and to be able to apply their mathematical knowledge in everyday situations in order to be successful in life beyond school. We intend to do this, on a daily basis, through developing all children's fluency in all areas of the mathematics national curriculum; providing opportunities to reason mathematically; and also develop children's using and applying skills when solving increasingly complex problems involving a range of mathematical knowledge.

Pupils in EYFS work towards being a "Master of Maths" through planned adult led activities and child initiated activities in the continuous provision.
